

Emergency Plan

fire brigade – emergency medical service 112
and/or from mobile phone 089 / 289-112

Call emergency service by witnesses or involved people if possible

Who	<i>calls</i>	
Where	did the accident happen	<i>address, floor, room number</i>
What	<i>happened</i>	<i>e.g., fire, chemical burn, falling down</i>
Which	<i>injuries</i>	<i>type and which part of the body</i>
How many	<i>injured persons</i>	<i>number</i>

Never hang up, let the rescue coordination center terminate the call!
Send a colleague outside to guide the rescue team!

In case of major injuries (heat and chemical burns, eye injuries, severe body injuries), always call the emergency medical service!

In case of minor injuries and stable blood circulation go to the next walk-in clinic or accident insurance consultant – never on your own!
